Household Hazardous Waste Materials accepted at no charge include agricultural pesticides, household cleaners, paints, stains, automotive, lawn and garden chemicals, fluorescent bulbs, rechargeable batteries, alkaline batteries, and related materials. Must show driver's licenses or tax statement indicating residency or land ownership in Mille Lacs County to participate.

Electronics: \$20 per television and monitor (all sizes), \$2 per small electronic device such as keyboards, mice, towers, DVD/VCR/Blue-ray players, internet routers, game consoles, Netflix equipment, laptops, speakers, etc.

Appliances: \$15 per appliance such as washers, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, freezers, dish washers, microwaves, blenders, coffee makers, bread makers, mixers, toasters, etc.
