REDISTRICTING PLAN  
(ADOPTED 4/17/2012)

The first district shall consist of the City of Princeton

The second district shall consist of the Townships of Princeton, Greenbush and Milo and the City of Pease.

The third district shall consist of the Township of Milaca and the Cities of Foreston and Milaca.

The fourth district shall consist of the Townships of Bogus Brook, Borgholm, Hayland, Page, Mudgett, Dailey, Lewis, Onamia and Bradbury and the City of Bock.

The fifth district shall consist of the Townships of Isle Harbor, South Harbor, Kathio and East Side and the Cities of Isle, Wahkon and Onamia.

The initial term for Districts 1, 3 and 5 shall expire after four years and the initial term for Districts 2 and 4 shall expire after two years in order to provide staggered terms on the county board. Thereafter, all commissioners shall be elected for four year terms.

In addition to redistricting of the county commissioner districts, Federal and State districts were also changed. The entire county remains within U. S. Congressional District 8 and the entire county also is within Minnesota Senate District 15
